OUTLINE:

SOT: "IT WENT FOR MY THIGH, AND I GRABBED IT AND PULLED IT OFF."

VO: SHERRI DEVORE AND HER FRIEND MARSHA RAN THE SAME PATH THEY ALWAYS DO, LIKE CLOCKWORK. THE SAME RUNNING SHOES AND SAME MUSIC PLAYLIST -- BUT THIS TIME INSTEAD OF ENDING UP BACK AT MARSHA'S HOUSE AFTER THEIR RUN -- THE TWO ENDED UP IN THE HOSPITAL

SOT: "I LOOKED BACK BEHIND HER AND SAW A COYOTE, AND THEN IT LUNGED AT HER AND BIT HER ON THE RIGHT CALF. THAT KNOCKED HER DOWN, AND THEN IT WENT FOR HER OTHER CALF."

VO: SHERRI AND MARSHA ARE NOT THE FIRST FRISCO RESIDENTS TO BE ATTACKED BY THE SO-CALLED "FRISCO COYOTE". IN FACT, THEY ARE THE SIXTH VICTIMS.

SOT: "WE HAD HEARD ABOUT THEM. THAT MORNING WHILE I WAS WAITING FOR MARSHA I THOUGHT I'M JUST GOING TO LOOK AND SEE WHAT TO DO IF THAT EVER DID HAPPEN TO US. SO THAT WAS ACTUALLY THE LAST THING ON MY PHONE WAS WHAT TO DO.

VO: THE CITY LAUNCHED AN INTERACTIVE MAP ALLOWING RESIDENTS TO REPORT THEIR SITTINGS, WITH THE HOPES THEY WILL BE ABLE TO TRACK DOWN THE AGGRESSIVE COYOTE.

SOT: "WE'VE WORKED WITH COMMUNITY SERVICES AND WORKED WITH OTHER AGENCIES AROUND US AND PART OF WHAT WE HAVE DONE IS CREATE AN ONLINE MAP SO FOLKS CAN HELP US TRACK WHERE THE COYOTES ARE. THE BEST WAY TO DO THAT IS HAVE THE PUBLIC TELL US WHERE THEY ARE SEEING THE MAJORITY OF THE COYOTES ESPECIALLY AROUND THE ELDORADO CORRIDOR.

VO: WITH THE NEW PROGRAM BY FRISCO PD, SHERRI SAYS SHE HOPES THESE ATTACKS ARE A THING OF THE PAST.

SOT: "I HOPE THEY TAKE CARE OF THE UNHEALTHY POPULATION OF COYOTES IN THE ARE."

VO: SO SHE CAN FEEL SAFE -- PUTTING ON THOSE SAME RUNNING SHOES ONCE AGAIN... FOR EAGLE NATION NEWS, I'M GRANT JOHNSON
