### Feedback:

- Voiceovers should not only transition your soundbytes but also provide some additional information and statistics. Let's add some facts. When is their season scheduled to start?
- You both did a great job keeping the natural sound on under the VOS but in this case I would actually mute it. This is because the music is playing in the weightroom and we don't want to infringe copyright by putting it in the package. Something I think should be added to the story is a nat. pop. This will really grab the viewers attention.
- The interviews are framed well just make sure to have them look at you and not the camera.
- The b-roll can be shifted around to be in sequences with wide, medium, tight and flavor shots.
- No need to say "Rock Hill" it is implied since it will be played for RHHHS students.
- Remember to write tight and don't state things that are obvious. Use details and the inverted pyramid writing structure.
